



## **Advisory Notice to Pleasure Vessel Cruising Permit**

### **The Small Craft (Control) Regulations 2017**

The Small Craft Control Act 2015 came into force on 1 January 2016.

In the context of these new regulations, a small pleasure craft is less than 24 metres in length and includes boats, canoes, dinghies, kayaks, paddle boards and jet skis, operating on inland waters and the coastal waters of Antigua and Barbuda.

Vessels operating under a cruising permit and/or small craft that may be deployed by them, within the definition above, are required to confirm they comply with the Small Craft Control Regulations 2017 and related Code of Practice standard.
