Agreements (SLAs) with ADOMS in accordance with the IMO Code for Recognized Organizations (RO Code), adopted by MEPC.237(65) and MSC.349(92), which became mandatory on 1 January 2015.

3. Additional Recognized Entities for Vessels Under 500 GT and Yacht

For commercial vessels under 500 GT and yachts, the following entities are authorized:
